

Query Diagnosis Case Study # 2

Admission date: Jan 1, 2024

Discharge date: Jan 5, 2024

MRDX: Query Cholangitis, possible cholangiocarcinoma

Past Medical History:

Breast ca- radiation treatment in 2022,

CKD,

HTN,

DM2,

CBD stones removed with ERCP in BC,

Smoker- ½ pack of cigarettes/day

Course in Hospital:

Patient admitted via ER with signs and symptoms suggestive of cholangitis. She was treated empirically with antibiotics.

Lately, her blood sugars have been consistently on the high side. The physician notes that her diabetes is out of control and appropriate treatment is given. On day 3, she was noted to be dehydrated and an increase in oral fluids was prescribed.

She had an MRI preformed which suggested the possibility of a cholangiocarcinoma.

On the morning of February 5, 2024 the patient was feeling well. She had no pain. She had no fever. Her vital signs were stable. She was therefore discharged home.
